Our evaluation strategy is integrating a trauma and violence-informed research frameworks to help us maintain a trauma and violence-informed perspective throughout the process in our evaluation plan.

Knowledge Hub Evaluation Plan

The Knowledge Hub is excited to soon begin the mid-term stage of an evaluation on members' experiences within the Trauma-Informed Community of Practice.

Research Questions:

- How effective is the Knowledge Hub in implementing the activities and events of the Trauma-Informed Community of Practice?
- To what extent and in what ways are the members of the Trauma-Informed Community of Practice experiencing value in their participation?

Data Collection:

- Online Survey (February 2024)
- Online Focus Groups (June & July 2024) co-facilitated by volunteer members of the CoP (training provided beforehand)

The end stage of the evaluation (2026) will continue looking at these themes, but also include measures specifically on knowledge mobilization efforts and collective value and impacts across the Trauma-Informed Community of Practice.
