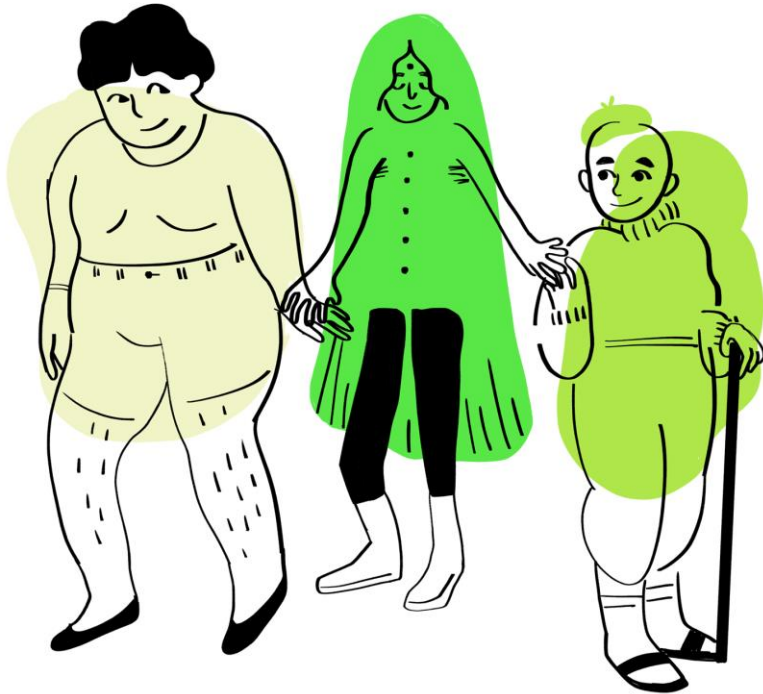

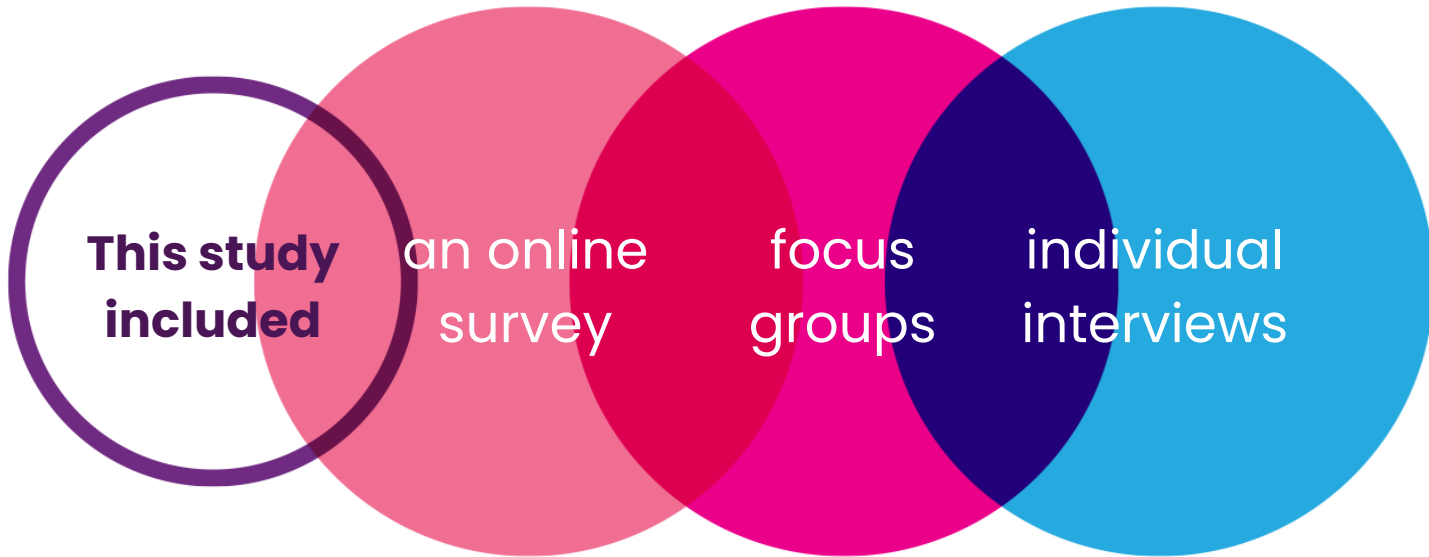
Peer Leadership Group

The TransFormed study engaged over 150 community members

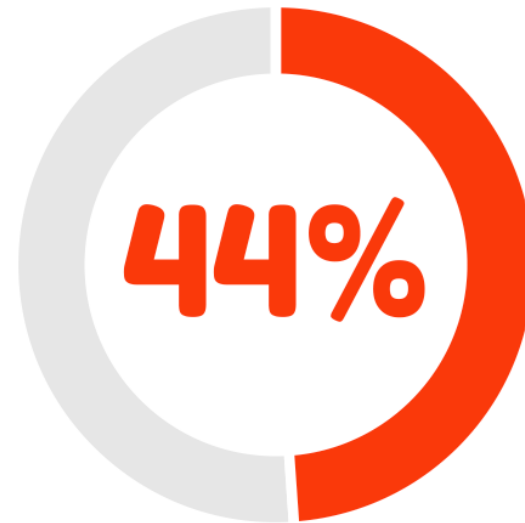


Supported by members of the **Peer Leadership Group**

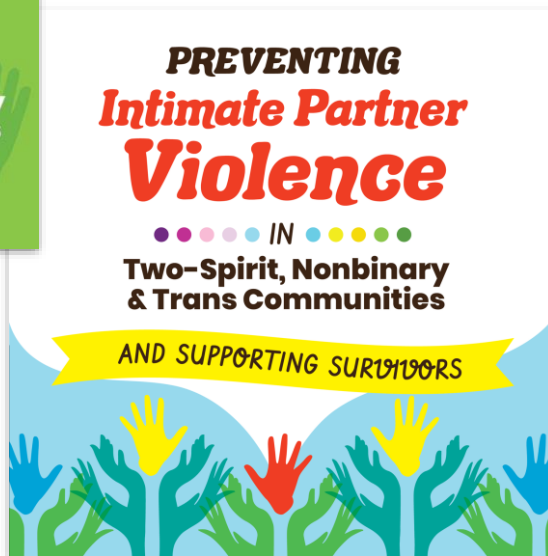
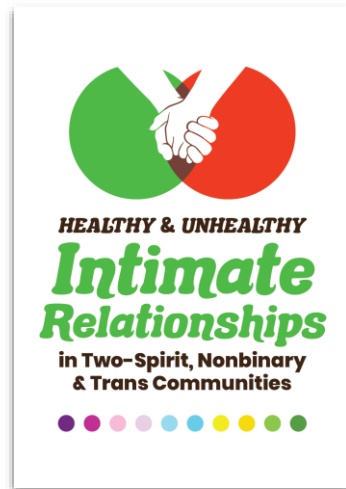
